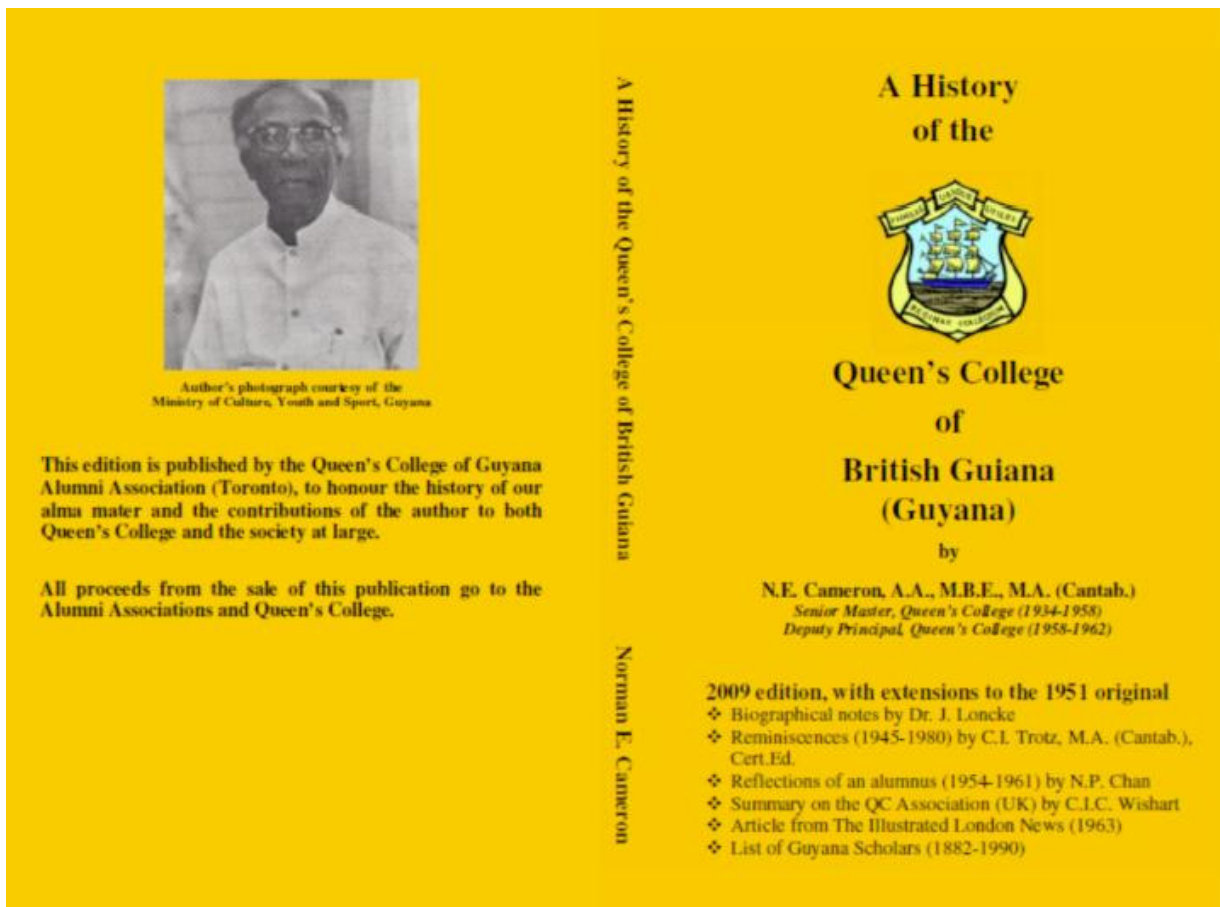


# A HISTORY OF THE QUEEN'S COLLEGE OF BRITISH GUIANA (GUYANA)

QCAA Toronto has published a new edition of N.E. Cameron's "A History of the Queen's College of British Guiana" which was originally published in 1951.

The main objectives of this new edition are to renew awareness of the school's development, to promote a greater appreciation of its achievements and its potential, to encourage support for the school, and to raise funds for all QC Associations selling the book in their locales.

The new edition contains several additions to the original that give a picture of the author, and of school life and school development after 1951:

- o Biographical notes on the author by Dr. Jocelyne Loncke;
- o Reminiscences (1945-1980) by Mr. C.I. Trotz, extending the tale beyond 1951 from the perspective of an outstanding student, master and Principal;
- o Reflections of an Alumnus (1954-1961) by N.P. Chan;
- o A summary of the Queen's College Association (UK) by C.I.C. Wishart;
- o A substantial article and pictorial from the 6 July 1963 Illustrated London News, featuring Queen's College;
- o The list of Guyana scholars inadvertently omitted from the original, with subsequent winners added.

The book is now available from the QC Association (UK) at a cost of £12, plus £1.36 p&p.
